

Established in November 2000 by a vote of the people from the City of Linden, the City of Fenton and Fenton Township under the Metropolitan District Act, PA 312 1929.


Perpetual .4 mil operating millage approved (rolled backed by Headlee Amendment).

Millage rate for 2015 was .3726

























Expense Trends










Contributions to the Loose Senior Center Total Contributed YTD \$1,133,272





Program Locations By Hours of Use






SLPR Paid the local School Districts for Facility Use Total Contribution in 2015 = **\$39,145.73**




SLP&R has many successful programs. We are particularly proud of our shining stars. These programs each have an estimated **200** unique participants.
