

Administration Organizational Chart






Southern Lakes Parks & Recreation Brief History

- Perpetual .4 mil operating millage approved (rolled backed by Headlee Amendment).
- Millage rate for 2014 was .3726




2014 L4028 Property Tax Est. Millage from SLPR District






Property Tax Revenue




Revenue Trends






Expense Trends












Contributions to the Loose Senior Center Total Contributed at 2014 YTD \$1,059,466




Participant Residency



Program Locations By Use




